

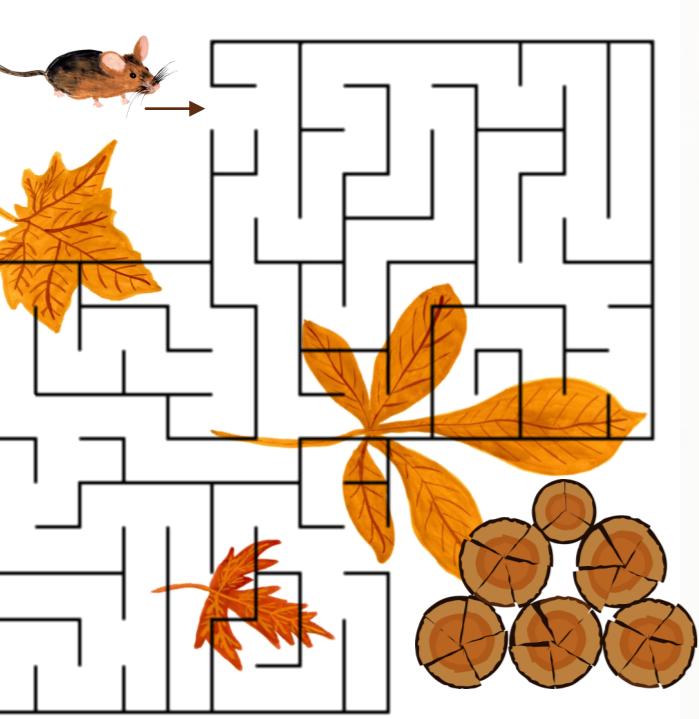

Nigel the mouse is looking for a warm place to hibernate over the winter. Can you help him find his way to the log pile?



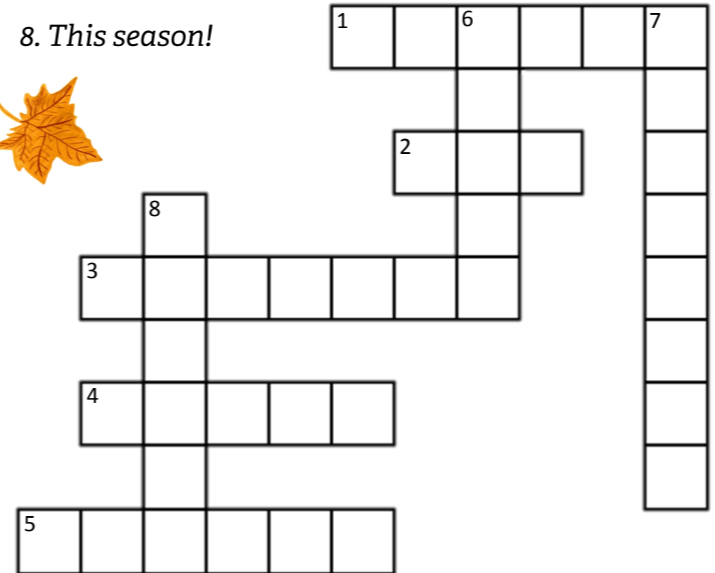

Have a go at making a leaf rubbing
