About the Countryside Enterprise and Small Business Award

The Award recognises rural and farming enterprises, as well as small businesses within the historic county of Lincolnshire who encourage and protect the wildlife and landscape of the county.

The Award is open to any type of rural business, from farming to nurseries, forestry and leisure. This is the second year we are also including small businesses for the Award.

Have you planted wildflowers for pollinator insects?
Is your small business environmentally friendly?
Have you restored or maintained hedgerows for wildlife?
Would the work of your business or enterprise inspire others?

Judging

Judging is carried out by an independent panel of experts in their field, selected for their impartiality, experience and suitability for each category. The initial shortlisting is based on the information provided. Shortlisted entrants may then be visited by a judge. Finalists will be asked to make a short eight minute presentation of their entry to the judges on Thursday 4th June 2020 at the Bentley Hotel in Lincoln. Finalists are invited to a Gala Dinner at the Bentley on the evening of June 4th when the winner of the category as well as the overall winner of the Lincolnshire Environmental Awards will be announced.

Conditions of entry

- For the initial stage of the competition entries should be a single page of 250-300 words and no additional documentation or material should be included. An entry form is provided on our website.
- You can enter directly or you can nominate a group for the award who you feel should be recognised for their work.
- The Lincolnshire Environmental Awards are not open to anyone connected to the sponsors or organisers.
- In all matters relating to the awards, the decision of the judges is final.

It's easy to enter. All you need to do is write 250-300 words describing your project and how it contributes to the environment or sustainable development.
