

Homemade Plastic Free Decorations

Pine Cone Hanging



Step 1
Arrange your pine cones into the pattern you would like.



Step 2
Take the pine cone that will be at the top of your pattern and start to wrap the garden wire around it, near the bottom. Remember to get the wire in as far as you can to minimise the risk of being able to see the wire.

Step 3

Leave a bit of wire sticking out at the top, as this will then become your hook later.



Step 4

Take your second pine cone and start to wrap the garden wire around it. To minimise the wire being shown I like to do a 'S' wrap round.

Step 5

Continue wrapping the garden wire around your remaining cones. You might need to wrap the wire around a cone again to secure the shape.



Step 6

When you are happy with your pattern, cut the wire using wire cutters and tuck it out of the way. Be careful as the wire can be sharp once cut.

Step 7

Take your decoration and slide it/wrap it around the wire left at the beginning. Bend the wire to create your hook for hanging.
