Role:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Suitable for anyone with an interest in wildlife and natural history, looking to begin a career in the conservation sector. - An exciting opportunity to join and assist the Gibraltar Point NNR team in managing one of Lincolnshire Wildlife Trust’s flagship nature reserve. - Work includes practical habitat management and species recording across a variety of different habitat types. Assisting with shorebird protection (April-August) to safeguard Lincolnshire’s only breeding colony of Little Terns and Ringed Plovers. Public engagement on a daily basis while carrying out reserve work and assisting with guided walks. Estate management and livestock husbandry.
Requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Good communication skills, team working and the ability to be self-motivated are essential. - A willingness to work outdoors in all weathers, a strong work ethic and the ability to adapt to a variety of situations is also required. - Enthusiasm to get stuck in to all jobs! - An interest in British natural history and a willingness to develop these skills. - A full driving license is essential due to the remoteness of Gibraltar Point and to allow candidates to experience opportunities off site. - Some previous experience of practical conservation work and species recording would be an advantage.
