Parental/Guardian Supervision

Parents/Guardians of Junior Wardens aged 16 years or younger are required to stay and supervise them when using tools. While not required for Junior Wardens aged 16+ or when no tool use in necessary, parents/guardians are welcome to stay for any session.

Each session costs £5.00 per Junior Warden, or £25.00 for a 6-Session Stamp Card. Payable in cash or card on arrival.
